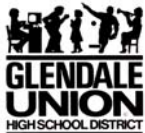

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Arizona Department of Revenue has issued guidelines that allow a state income tax credit of up to \$400* for fees contributed by a taxpayer to a public school for the support of extracurricular activities. (ARS § 43-1089.01)

It is not a requirement that the taxpayer have a child enrolled in a public school.

(*\$400 for married couples filing jointly, \$200 for married couples filing separately or \$200 for single individuals or heads of household.)

Remember . . .

Your contribution must be postmarked by December 31 of the taxable year for which the credit is claimed.

Arizona Department of Revenue Guidelines

ARS § 43-1089.01

- ◆ The credit is applied against the taxpayer’s Arizona state income tax.
- ◆ “Extracurricular activities” are defined as “... school-sponsored educational activities that require enrolled students to pay a fee in order to participate.”
- ◆ Checks must be made payable to the school.
- ◆ The credit is available for any *personal* state income tax return.
- ◆ It is not a requirement that the taxpayer have a child enrolled in the public school.
- ◆ The credit is limited to \$400 for married couples filing jointly, \$200 for married couples filing separately, or \$200 for single individuals or heads of household.

**NOTE: The school district does not issue refunds.
Consult your tax advisor to determine how the tax credit will affect your tax return.**

Commonly Asked Questions

Q Can I still contribute to the school if I already paid more in taxes through payroll deduction than I owed and am now due a refund?

A You will receive a larger tax refund, provided your total tax liability is at least equal to the credit in the first place.

Q What if I owe additional monies for state income tax?

A You may reduce your taxes owed by the credit allowed.

For example:

◆ If a total of \$1,000 was deducted from your earnings during the year, and at tax time your Arizona income tax liability was only \$700, the Arizona Department of Revenue would owe you \$300 without a school tax credit.

Your refund check = \$300

◆ If, however, you had contributed \$400 to a public school, the Arizona Department of Revenue would refund you the \$300—PLUS another \$400 refund for the school tax credit.

Your refund check = \$700

◆ If a total of \$1,000 was deducted during the year and your total Arizona income tax liability was \$1,500, you would still owe \$500. You could reduce your tax balance due by the \$400 school tax credit.

Your reduced taxes owed = \$100
